## **ABBREVIATIONS & MINISTRY NAMES WE OFTEN USE:**

**UPC:** United Pentecostal Church (UPCI-United Pentecostal Church, International)

**CGC:** Calvary Gospel Church

**Kids Depot:** Our congregation's childcare/preschool

**KidzRageous:** CGC's Sunday school program for children ages 6 through 11

**TNT: TeeNexTreme** - the youth group/program at CGC

**Ignite:** Youth Service typically held on Wednesday evening

**Hyphen:** National and local ministry for ages 18 to 30

**CIP:** Christian Intervention Program - Bible-based AODA (alcohol & other drug abuse) training

**ARISE:** A separate organization/ministry that was an outgrowth of our CIP; provides services in Madison to people being released from incarceration, particularly those with AODA problems

### **Annual Offerings**

**CFC:** Christmas for Christ - an offering taken across our fellowship at Christmas time to establish new churches (in North America – 40% stays in Wisconsin)

**SFC:** Sheaves for Christ - Annual UPC Youth Department offering (part stays in our district youth department) primarily provides transportation to our missionaries: cars, bicycles, planes, and boats

**Mother's Memorial (MM):** Annual UPC Ladies Ministry offering - primarily provides appliances to missionaries, supports local bible study students, and sends birthday gifts to missionaries' children

**Save Our Children (SOS):** Annual offering based on attendance on Easter that benefits the General Sunday School Division of the UPC

### **Other UPC Ministries We Support**

***Lighthouse Ranch for Boys:*** Facility for troubled boys

***New Beginnings:*** Maternity home that also facilitates adoptions for the children who are born

***Tupelo Children's Mansion:*** A campus in Tupelo, Mississippi, where orphaned children are lovingly raised in a Christ-based, home-like atmosphere

***Spirit of Freedom:*** National UPC program which administers the **CIP program** and otherwise ministers to those with AODA needs

***Compassion International:*** Provides help to people anywhere in the world in times of natural disasters, such as Hurricane Katrina and the Indonesian tsunami.

Calvary Gospel Church also helps to support the Wisconsin District Campgrounds at Shawano; Our "very own" missionaries, Lenny and Kathy Smith in Antigua, as well as missionaries all over the world; and a benevolence fund within our own congregation.

God has greatly blessed us, enabling us to reach out in all these different ways to tell the unsaved about Jesus Christ and to minister to the needs of people all over the world!
